



Donor Response – International Federation of Red Cross Red Crescent Societies

The financial resources available to the IFRC come from 3 main sources: 1. statutory contributions from its member National Societies; 2. Voluntary contributions from its member National Societies and donations from partners and donors, either unrestricted or to support specific humanitarian response and thematic activities; 3. Other income and cost recoveries.

This report provides an overview of voluntary contributions and donations to the IFRC, it does not include statutory contributions from National Societies nor other income and cost recoveries. It includes contributions and donations to the IFRC Plan of the relevant year (regular resources, thematic and special purposes funds*), IFRC Emergency appeals and hosted projects.

*Special purpose funds are National Society Investment Alliance (NSIA), Forecast-Based Action Fund, (FBA), Capacity Building Fund (CBF), and Disaster Relief Emergency Funds (DREF).

The report also includes funding from the European Commission to support the cash assistance programme in Turkey through the Emergency Social Safety Net (ESSN).

The European Commission provided a total contribution of EUR 900 million (EUR 500 million in 2019 and EUR 400 million in 2020) to the implementation of the ESSN programme (for the period from September 2019 to October 2022).
