Snapshot



More than 90 people have died and an estimated 4,118 people have been affected by a series of wildfires that ripped through the Attica region of Greece in late July. The fires were a worst-case scenario due to the high-density forest, strong winds, and high temperatures.

This appeal will enable the Hellenic Red Cross and IFRC to support 7,100 of the most vulnerable survivors for nine months. The operation will include support in health, livelihoods, protection and disaster risk reduction, community engagement and accountability, and National Society development.
